Cardiac Liaison Nurse



Who is the Cardiac Liaison Nurse?

The Cardiac Liaison Nurse provides inpatient education, discharge planning and care coordination to patients and their carers with a new or existing diagnosis of:

Ischaemic Heart Disease – including STEMI, NSTEMI, unstable angina, angina or coronary artery disease.

Heart Failure – including left ventricular failure, right ventricular failure, congestive cardiac failure and acute pulmonary oedema.


Atrial Fibrillation – including atrial flutter, chronic atrial fibrillation or paroxysmal atrial fibrillation/flutter.

The Cardiac Liaison Nurse educates patients on risk factor reduction, symptoms, self-management strategies and provides referrals to Community Services Programs to support transition and recovery such as Cardiac Rehabilitation, Hospital Admissions Risk Program (HARP) or Palliative Care.
